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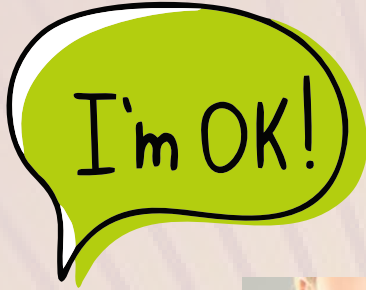

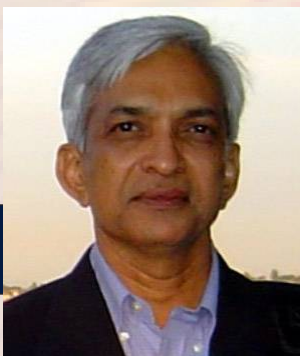
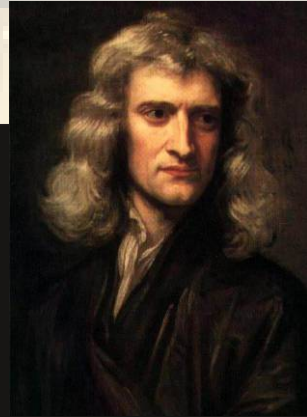

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Dear Pharmacist,

Season's greetings!

I'm OK!

Today I am happy to state that WORLD PHARMACIST DAY 25.9.2022 has been a grand success across several places. In particular, at a small place called Belthangady (South Kanara district of Karnataka), the chemists and druggists association celebrated World Pharmacist Day in the most unique, pragmatic and elegant manner that I have ever come across, and all thanks to KRPA that recommended me to be the Chief Guest of their function!

The Belthangady Chemists and Druggists Association not only organized a lecture by me on burning pharma issues like the Drugs, Medical Devices and Cosmetics Act 2022, NLEM 2022 etc; they also gave a good sum of cash to each needy beneficiary (total, 10 beneficiaries) who are in dire straits due to ill health and financial stress. Further they provided a 5 L can of calcium supplement to each needy dairy farmer (total 10 beneficiaries). This is not only altruism but also builds a bank of goodwill thereby increasing flow of purchasers to their pharmacies. This sort of exemplary stewardship can come only when individuals are rooted in the mental status: I AM OK!

So let us see what this 'I AM OK' is?!

Transactional analysis

The field of psychoanalysis has an interesting topic called transactional analysis (TA), which is an extraordinary instrument of self-development. In TA, an individual is said to operate in the child ego state, parent ego state or adult ego state depending on the situation or he may have one of these traits as strongly embedded in his or her persona. The child ego state is transparent, based on impulses, creative and full of life energy. The parent ego state is either nurturing (caring) or controlling (critical), thus people with parent ego state are instructive and do mentoring. The adult ego state refers to a person who is a problem solver, like the computer, and a data driven personality. There is no right or wrong ego state, depending on the circumstance, an intelligent person uses the appropriate ego state for win-win relationship, or mutualism.

I'M OK, YOU'RE OK

In 1967, a psychiatrist called Thomas A Harris wrote an iconic self-help book called I'M OK, YOU'RE OK, based on transactional analysis. The central idea is to consider oneself always as being OK. Not being apologetic or over confident, just quietly feeling that oneself is ok and accepting of oneself. This obviously leads to self-analysis, self-correction, self-development and supreme self-confidence. When a person feels that he or she is ok and is self-confident, his or her ability to communicate, negotiate, manage relationships, manage one's own emotions and faculty of concentration too improves, thereby he or she is a happy and successful person.

In another step forward, Thomas A Harris recommends that an individual ought to operate out of the mental status: I'M OK, YOU'RE OK. This means while transacting in a relationship, the person with this mindset is non-judgmental plus open minded. This makes the person have a more robust negotiation skill and can establish win-win relationships.

Today, crucial to each pharmacist is to tether his or her mind in the mental status of I'M OK, YOU'RE OK; this will make the pharmacist judiciously assertive and accommodative -

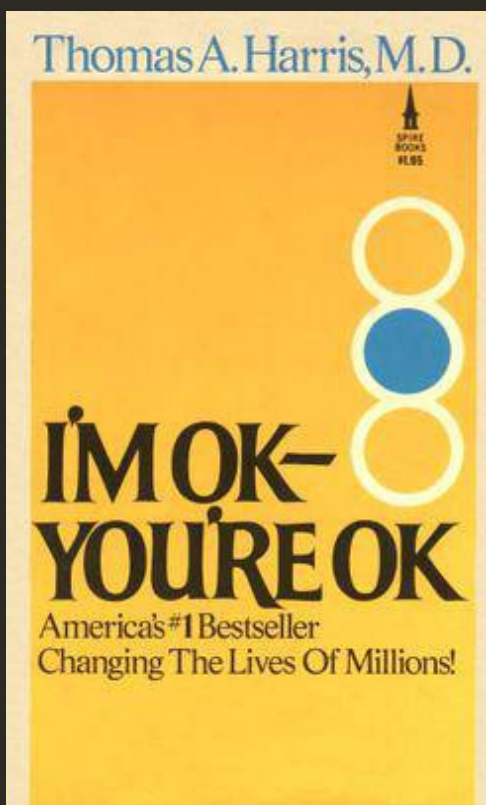

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HYPOTHYROIDISM

The Facts You Need to Know Myth Busters



The prevalence of hypothyroidism in India is around 11% and is on the rise as a result of rampant lifestyle changes and associated stressors. In an epidemiological study, it was found that 1 in 10 of the study participants were affected by the condition, and it was significantly associated with older age and the female gender. [1] That being stated, hypothyroidism is a fairly common endocrinological disorder and we may know several family members, friends and acquaintances that have been diagnosed and being treated for it. On being diagnosed with hypothyroidism, while it may be reassuring to speak with such individuals and share experiences, it is important to beware of hearsay and to verify information. Here are some Myths vs. Facts pertaining to hypothyroidism:

Myths and facts about Hypothyroidism

1. **Myth:** Only females can be diagnosed with Hypothyroidism
Fact: Hypothyroidism can be seen in both males and females. However, the prevalence rates are more in females (five to eight times) than males.
2. **Myth:** Hypothyroidism can only affect older people
Fact: Hypothyroidism can be present in individuals of any age.
3. **Myth:** It is impossible to manage weight or lose weight with hypothyroidism
Fact: It is possible to manage weight by regularly taking effective dosage of medicines.
4. **Myth:** Taking more dosages of thyroid medication can provide more energy and help to reduce weight
Fact: It is always recommended to take the prescribed dosages of thyroid medication and not to double them. Doubling the dosages can be associated with side effects.
5. **Myth:** Hypothyroidism causes fatigue throughout
Fact: Fatigue is one of a common symptom observed in Hypothyroidism but can be managed by medications. Persisting fatigue after correction of hypothyroidism needs evaluation for other causes.
6. **Myth:** Hypothyroidism can be efficiently managed with diet
Fact: Hypothyroidism can be managed by taking the medications regularly and also by adopting a healthy diet

7. **Myth:** Hypothyroidism can lead to the development of Goiter
Fact: Majority of patients with Hypothyroidism do not have goiters
8. **Myth:** Hypothyroidism patients must not eat broccoli
Fact: Occasional consumption of broccoli, cauliflower and kale is permissible. Avoided in patient who have thyroid swelling with nodules (Goiter).
9. **Myth:** All thyroid swellings are cancer
Fact: only five percent of thyroid nodules are cancerous.

Additional:

Myth: Having hypothyroidism makes it impossible to conceive.

Fact: Unless the condition is completely neglected and treatment is not pursued, it is possible to plan and have a successful pregnancy in consultation with your HCP.

Myth: Taking extra iodine will resolve the condition

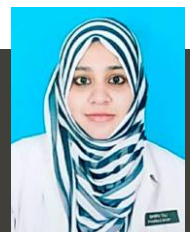
Fact: While iodine is essential for the thyroid gland to function optimally, taking too much iodine has its own consequences. Simple measures such as shifting to an iodized salt would suffice.

Myth: Thyroid medications can be discontinued once the thyroid hormone levels have normalized

Fact: The normalizing of thyroid hormone levels is an indicator that the medication is working. Discontinuing the medication would result in an imbalance in those levels again. Do not discontinue the medication unless advised by the HCP.

While these common myths would be busted after reading this article, you may have some questions of your own that may have not been covered here as different regions and cultures have their own set of misconceptions regarding various conditions. 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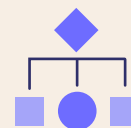
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NEWTON'S LAWS OF MOTION FOR GROWTH

Newton's laws of motion are not only used in science but you can use them to be a better version of yourself.

Newton's Laws of Motion:

1st Law: The state of an object remains the same unless an external force acts on it.

2nd Law: For an externally applied force, the change in velocity depends on the mass of the object.

3rd Law: For every action (force) in nature, there is an equal and opposite reaction.

Now the question is
How it is applicable to us in life and / how can we interpret to use it ?

My view towards

1st Law : The state of an object remains the same unless a external force acts on it

"Your life or career will remain at rest or in uniform motion in a straight line unless compelled to change its state by the action of an internal or external force."

So, external force is actually in favour of us, as it is helping us to develop/grow

I'll take it one step further to explain...

But, don't always wait for an external force to change self

It may never come, or it may come up in a way you don't want:

Positive consequences of external force: (When you are able to accept the change, prepared and work on it, cooperate, collaborate, show willingness to change)

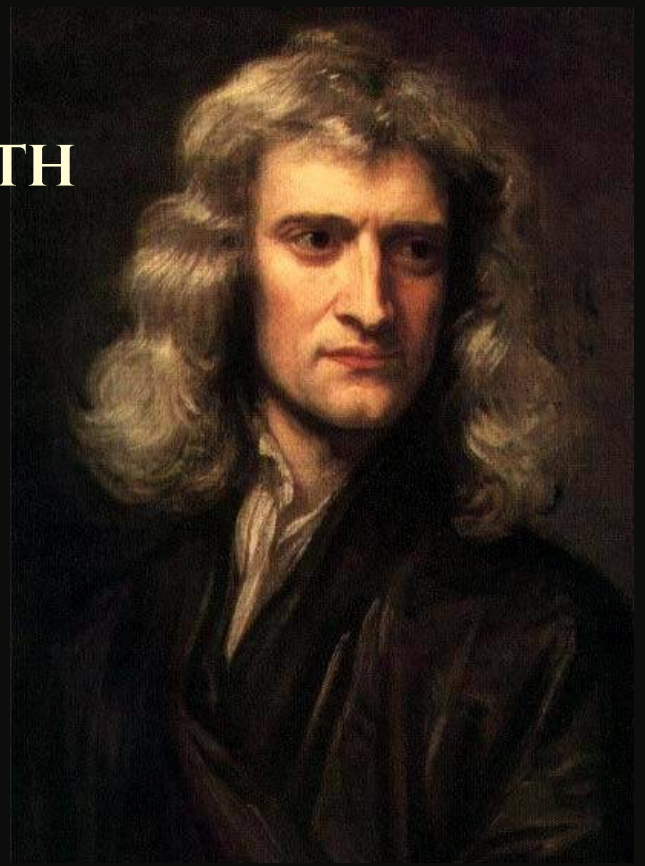
Job growth, career growth, self esteem grows, high confidence, courage, societal connections, praised and liked by people around, financial freedom, healthy relationships, ...etc

Negative Consequences of external force : (When you are unable to accept the change, not prepared and don't work on it, unwilling to cooperate, collaborate, show unwillingness to change)

Job loss, relationship loss, image loss, low confidence, quitting habit, bad habits, societal issues, divorce, health issues, addictions, affairs, prison, etc.

So, Go within, connect with what matters to you, what needs to be done, what is being expected to achieve as it helps in self/ career growth and be the internal force/ self motivated of change you desire.

2nd Law : For an externally applied force, the change in velocity depends on the mass of the object.



Example: When we kick the ball we exert force in a specific direction, which is why the ball will move in some direction. Now, the point is how forcefully the ball moves forward depends on the force with which ball being kicked.

When an external force is being applied, the change is the key to bring out the results. Now, positive results is dependent on the person's ability to hold the pressure and stretch himself to move forward. The ability to adopt and willingness to act is the only way forward to get the desired/ forced desired.

Hence, change in behavior depends on the person's ability to take up the external force in right spirit (only with internal desired to change state of mind) and act upon to attain the desired outcome.

3rd Law: For every action (force) in nature, there is an equal and opposite reaction

Example- While walking on the beach with our feet, we exert some push force on the sand backward so as to move forward.

The other example can be when someone fires a gun, the action force pulls the bullet outside the gun, and the reaction force pushes the gun backward.

Similarly, so as to move forward in life, we must have done some experiments, go through some experience and need be may have to ignore, forget, forgive, overlook, on certain mistakes that has been done in the past but definitely need to carry the learnings of it. Let the past experience be the inspiration for the push forward.

More the desire, more is the action.

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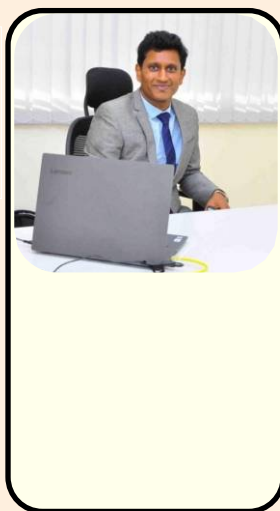
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Report Of Webinar On “Encouraging Adverse Drug Reaction Reporting by Patients”

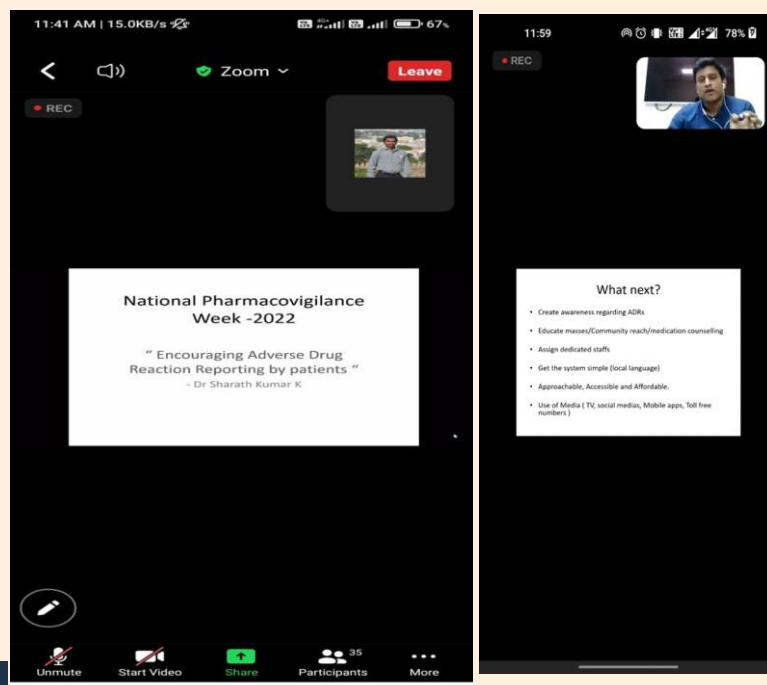

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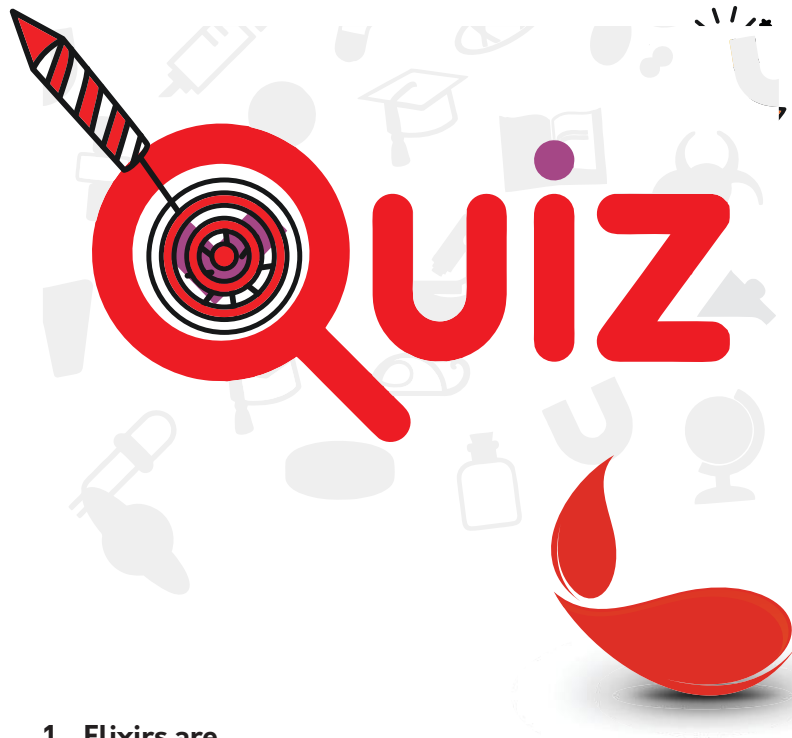

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DR. S.K. KULKARNI

Kulkarni** born
on December

1946 hails from Basavana Bagewadi of Bijapur district. He is a graduate from Govt. College of Pharmacy, Bengaluru holding the First position in B. Pharm degree. He was a visiting Scholar of US-Education Foundation (1987-89), consultant to WHO and member of Indian Pharmacopeia Committee (1990-2000). Professor Kulkarni is a former Pro-Vice Chancellor, Punjab University, Chandigarh and presently he is an Emeritus professor of Pharmacology at University Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Punjab University. Currently he resides in Belagavi.

He has been serving as a visiting professor at the University of British Columbia, Texas Health Sciences University, University of Oklahoma and University of Illinois, and most recently to the University of the West Indies, Trinidad. He was also a visiting professor to Indian institutions- JIPMER, NIMHANS, BITS and JSS Universities. He served as the Director, Bombay College of Pharmacy, University of Mumbai (2009-2013).

Dr Kulkarni has published more than 500 research papers more than 200 review and professional articles, 5 patents and 13 books. His recent book (co-authored) entitled 'Pharmacologists of India' which covers pharmacology research in India during the last seven decades.

For his distinguished contribution in the field of experimental pharmacology, Stanford University has named Professor Shrinivas Krishnarao Kulkarni as the 'Top Pharmacologist from India' (Rank-1). He ranks First in India and 132nd in the world (Rank world-wide by subject area) with 503 papers submitted by him. Also other accolades and National recognitions include UGC- Hari Om Ashram Trust National Award in Neuroscience, Ranbaxy Research Foundation Award, Acharya P.C. Ray Gold medal, Professor G.P.Srivastava Memorial National Award, and Life-time achievement award of the Association of Pharmaceutical Teachers of India.

S. K. Kulkarni re-engineered pharmacology teaching and research through translational approach. His vision about a radical change in teaching of pharmacology at undergraduate level which is necessary to ensure that future generation of prescribers to be well versed with the fundamental principles that underlie good clinical practice is of great significance.

Many years ago while delivering the Col. Ram Nath Chopra (regarded as the 'Father of Indian Pharmacology') oration at the annual conference of Indian Pharmacological Society (IPS), professor Kulkarni highlighted about the challenges facing the drug discovery science and cautioned about the increasing gap in pharmacology training between India and the rest of the world. At the global level, research is moving forward with great pace and inevitably new areas of challenges will emerge. In a competitive world and globalised development, we cannot be left behind. As per the McKinsey and Company projections, the emerging markets of BRIC nations (Brazil, Russia, India, and China) will account for nearly half of the growth in the global pharmaceutical industry. It is also expressed that one of the biggest challenges of comprehending and capturing the market is the shortage of specialized talent or human resources, particularly in the areas of systems biology, clinical research, and healthcare delivery. Pharmaceutical graduates and trained pharmacologists have a great role to play in realizing the "India Advantage."

Dr. Kulkarni has made a revolutionary change towards the development of Indian pharmacology by showering his tremendous knowledge in experimental pharmacology through his books, research articles and various citations. His commendable approach of making experimental pharmacology mandatory in UG level of both pharmacy and medical sciences is the prominent factor that helps to shape the future generation of Indian pharmacologists for a better India at the global market. No doubt his tireless contribution for Indian pharmacology makes him the 'most aspired pharmacologist of India'.

Dr. Kulkarni's vision and commitment towards the betterment of pharmacy education in our country is a true inspiration to all of us. He holds the credit for transforming thousands of students by guiding them to recognize their passion and lead successful lives. With immense gratitude we would like to wish Professor S. K.
